continuing on lots 51, 103, 58, 20, 68, 87, and Lots 134, 136, 137, 138 and 139 on Snow Top. As of October 1st, 33 homes have been completed, with eight of those listed for sale. There are currently eleven homes under construction and at least three more are going through Design Review.

Lots 51, 58 and 103, were started in late fall of last year and are nearing completion. The four new homes on Snow Top that were started in September have set the fastest building pace seen here at Deer Crest. Lot 68 has spent quite a bit of time

breaking into some tough rock and has finally completed their foundation. Lot 20 however was able to dig with considerable ease and their framing is already starting to take shape.

The Townhomes at Jordanelle Village are looking great and the new owners are looking forward to another great season. The next phase is still in the works and should be building soon.

Lot 87 hides its actual size from Jordanelle View Drive and the Jordanelle Ski Run but gives a terrific impression when you ski around the corner on Home Run Trail. It features a four-story spiral staircase and a sky light in the entrance of the home. Quite spectacular! The expected completion date is late spring of 2005.

A few of the trails have been impacted by the construction, which is common, but improvements have been made and they are looking great for this winter. Lot 120 even put sod on the ski trail in front of their home. We might be setting a new precedence here! Have a great winter!

Dear Deer Crest Property Owner,

Another beautiful fall season has passed at Deer Crest and the first snow has already fallen on the hillsides. Some of the summer months were above normal in precipitation and some were considerably below normal and predictions for the up coming winter are just about as varied, but the snow guns are out in place on the ski trails to provide a little insurance against the fickleness of mother nature.

This summer saw a major resurfacing of all the roads in Deer Crest. A "type three" (roughest surface for best winter traction) slurry seal was applied and it should be three years before another lighter surfacing is needed. The capital reserves are set up and funded from the Association dues to insure that the roads and infrastructure at Deer Crest are kept in excellent condition.

The operations crew kept busy this summer installing forty Colorado blue spruce trees, one hundred flowering shrubs, one thousand bulbs, over five hundred pounds of grass seed and a lot of bark mulch and wild flower seeds.

It will be held on Saturday, January 15th at 5 p.m. at The Lodges at Deer Valley, which is located at 2900 Deer Valley Drive East. Deer Valley Resort Invests \$8 million in Improvements for the 2004/2005 season

The \$8 million in improvements for the 2004/2005 ski season at Deer Valley will include the following:

- Two new chairlifts, the Judge Lift and the Silver Strike Express, will be installed in the Flagstaff area of the Resort. The Judge lift is a fixed-grip triple chair and the Silver Strike Express lift will be a detachable quad chair.
- The Resort's Flagstaff area will also be home to two new intermediate ski runs. The runs will be accessible off of the new Silver Strike Express lift, Quincy Express, Red Cloud lift and the Northside Express lift.
- Additional glade skiing is being added in both the Empire Canyon and Flagstaff areas of the Resort.
- Due to great popularity during its inaugural season last winter, Deer Valley will offer its Fireside Dining at Empire Lodge two nights a week during ski season, on both Wednesday and Thursday evenings.
